

# The Last Refugees

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There have been numerous refugee crises over the past few decades and the last major one is still ahead. The only way to know who will be involved, and why it is going to happen, depends upon a correct rendering of numerous prophecies in God's word. Although this is a story that goes back millennia, it is the intention of this document to be as brief as possible.

Because economic instability and war contributes to refugee crises, God taught a specific family about His laws and their job was to explain these to all the other nations on earth so that universal peace and prosperity would be achieved on a permanent basis. Sadly, this family rejected the job God gave them and, as a result, the world has suffered ever since.

However, before proceeding further, it must be emphasized that when Almighty God gives someone a job to do, they can walk away but eventually they will have to fulfill it. Jonah is a case in point because he was tasked with warning the people of Nineveh that they would be destroyed if they did not cease from their evil conduct. Jonah refused to carry out this commission, and attempted to escape by boarding a ship. Shortly after departing, he was tossed into the sea and swallowed by a large sea creature. This creature then spewed Jonah on to the shore. At this point Jonah realized he could no longer ignore the command that God gave him; so he completed his mission. This principle needs to be applied to the last refugees who will be moved from around the world to one location because they are the descendants of the original family that walked away from their responsibility, and God will make sure they fulfill the job given to their forefathers, because a permanent state of world peace depends upon it.

This family began with Abram whose name was later changed to Abraham. So it was a small beginning with a huge responsibility and, contrary to popular opinion, Abraham was not Jewish.

***You are the Lord God, who chose Abram, and brought him out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gave him the name Abraham*** (Neh. 9:7; NKJV used throughout unless otherwise noted; emphasis added).

God then made a promise to Abraham that will never be revoked.

*As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of a multitude of nations* (not just the nation of Judah – known as the Jews). *No longer shall your name be called Abram* (exalted father), *but your name shall be Abraham* (father of a multitude); *for I have made you a father of many nations.* <sup>6</sup>*I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you.* <sup>7</sup>*And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.* <sup>8</sup>*Also I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession; and I will be their God* (Gen. 17:4-8; Ed. notes in parentheses; emphasis added).

Therefore, many different nations would come from Abraham's descendants and there would be kings, and rulers, among them. One of the greatest of these would become known as the Messiah, or Jesus Christ, who would become a blessing to every nation on earth through his

shed blood that removes the sin of everyone who repents (Heb. 9:22; cf. Acts 2:38).

.... *And in you* (one of Abraham's descendants; Christ) ***all the families of the earth shall be blessed*** (Gen. 12:3b; Ed. note in parenthesis; emphasis added).

.....*God* (the Father), *having raised up His servant Jesus*, ***sent him to bless you***, *in turning away every one of you from your iniquities* (sins) (Acts 3:26b; Ed. notes in parentheses).

This future ruler, who is also referred to as *the King of kings and Lord of lords* (cf. Rev. 19:11-16), was prophesied to come from one of Abraham's twelve descendants, who were known by the following names during the First Covenant period: (Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Zebulun, Isaachar, Dan, Gad, Asher, Naphtali, Joseph, and Benjamin; cf. Gen. 49:1-28).

*The scepter* (symbol of kingship) *shall not depart from Judah* (nation of the Jews), *nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; and to him* (Christ) *shall be the obedience of the people* (Gen. 49:10; cf. Gen. 49:11; Zech. 9:9; Mt. 21:1-5; Ed. notes in parentheses).

Also God promised a large tract of land, which would be an integral part of this everlasting promise, and it would be divided among Abraham's twelve descendants. And, if Abraham's descendants rebelled against God's covenant by transgressing His law and commandments, they would be punished accordingly. This would include being driven off the land, which occurred between the 8<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> centuries BCE respectively. However, because of God's promise to Abraham, these twelve nations will eventually return to their original inheritance. However, it is a great deception to

believe that the modern nation named "Israel" comprises all of Abraham's twelve descendants. It simply does not. The majority of Abraham's children are scattered globally among many nations and they are not easily identified because they have, for the most part, adopted the pagan customs of these nations (i.e., Christmas, which is the worship of Mithras, with Christ's name applied to it; Easter, after the goddess Ishtar, with Christ's sacrifice applied to it; naming the days of the week after pagan gods, worshiping weekly on "*the day of the sun*" as opposed to God's sabbath which is Saturday, etc.) Nonetheless, they have been a blessing to these nations, just as Joseph was a blessing to the foreign nation he lived in, which was Egypt. However, Joseph did not purposely transgress God's commands as the modern descendants of Abraham consistently do. As a result these nations today, with Abraham's descendants in positions of political, religious, and commercial leadership, are quickly declining in power and significance. In fact, with the present trajectory they are on track to become "*the tail and not the head*" as God foretold they would.

*He* (foreign lender) *shall lend to you, but you shall not* (be able to) *lend to him* (due to foolish fiscal policies); ***he shall be the head, and you shall be the tail*** (Dt. 28:44; Ed. notes in parentheses; emphasis added).

This is why democratic countries like America, Britain, France, etc. are now "leading from behind", and eventually things will get so bad that the descendants of Abraham in these nations will become refugees who are transported back to the Middle East. This is the time described as "*Jacob's trouble*" because the majority of Abraham's descendants, through his son Jacob, are approaching the point that Jonah did. They will soon be faced with the realization that they, as did their forefathers, ignored the job God gave them and because they have

consistently rejected God's commands, they will now "reap what they have been sowing". This future time of great adversity will affect the descendants of Judah (the Jews) as well as the other eleven families that descended from Jacob. The latter group are collectively known by the name Israel, because it is their father's name (cf. Gen. 32:28). To confirm this truth, the name "Israel" was transferred to Joseph's two sons Ephraim and Manasseh.

*Then Israel (formerly known as Jacob) stretched out his right hand and laid it on Ephraim's head, who was the younger, and his left hand on Manasseh's head, guiding his hands knowingly, for Manasseh was the firstborn. <sup>15</sup>And he blessed Joseph, and said: "God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, the God who has fed me all my life long to this day, <sup>16</sup>The Angel who has redeemed me from all evil, **bless the lads** (Ephraim and Manasseh); **let my name** (Israel) **be named upon them...** (Gen. 48:14-16a; Ed. notes in parentheses; emphasis added).*

Therefore, whoever the descendants of Ephraim and Manasseh are today, they are Israelites, and as they are not descended from the family of Judah, they are not Jews. Again, they do not know their real identity and they do not believe it is their responsibility to observe God's laws and commands, which include His appointed days of worship. As Christ confirmed, these "appointed times" were created for all mankind, and it was one of Israel's responsibilities to teach them to all the nations of the world.

*And he (Christ) said to them, "**The Sabbath was made for man**(kind) ..... (Mk. 2:27a; Ed. notes in parentheses; emphasis added).*

*Now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the judgments which I teach you to observe (Dt.*

*4:1a) ...for **this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples** (in other countries) **who will hear all these statutes, and say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.'** (Dt. 4:6b; Ed. note in parenthesis; emphasis).*

*Now therefore, if you (Jacob's twelve families) will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. <sup>6</sup>And **you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests** (to teach God's laws to all nations) **and a holy nation...** (Ex. 19:5-6; Ed. notes in parentheses; emphasis added).*

Sadly, instead of teaching other nations about God's value system, many of Jacob's descendants are ignoring and/or breaking every law and commandment. By doing so, they are **not** teaching other nations the right way to live. And yet, amazingly, many of these same people are shocked that other countries hate "the west" and would like to destroy it. In the remaining prophecies about modern-day Jacob/Israel, it should become apparent that foreigners will come very close to achieving their goal,

*Now these are the words that the Lord spoke concerning Israel (eleven of Jacob's descendants) and Judah (the twelfth descendant of Jacob). <sup>5</sup>For thus says the Lord: 'We (in the angelic realm) have heard **a voice of trembling, of fear, and not peace.** <sup>6</sup>Ask now, and see, whether a man is ever in labor with child? So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins like a woman in labor, and all faces turned pale? <sup>7</sup>**Alas! For that day is great, so that none is like it; and it is the time of Jacob's trouble..** (Jer. 30:4-7a; cf. Amos 5:18-20; Ed. notes in parentheses; emphasis added).*

This prophecy has not been fulfilled yet because it was written after the captivity and dispersion of Jacob's descendants who lived in the northern kingdom with its capital in Samaria. This defeat was at the hands of the Assyrian king Shalmaneser V from 726-721 BCE. Therefore, Jeremiah is describing an even greater calamity that will befall all twelve families that descended from Jacob in the future. Also, as prophesied, many who read this information will simply scoff at it.

*Knowing this first: that **scoffers will come in the last days**, walking according to their own lusts, <sup>4</sup>and **saying, "Where is the promise of his (Christ's) coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation."** (2Pet. 3:3-4; Ed. note in parenthesis; emphasis added).*

Continuing with Jeremiah's warning for our time, Jacob's/Israel's modern-day descendants will suffer severe consequences for their sinful actions and no other nations will come to their aid. These other nations are described figuratively, and sarcastically, as "lovers".

***All your lovers have forgotten you; they do not seek you; For I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy, with the chastisement of a cruel one, for the multitude of your iniquities, because your sins have increased** (Jer. 30:14).*

America has gone to its "lovers" a number of times over the past two years asking them for favors.

*Axios reported Sunday (March 6, 2022) that Biden's senior advisers were considering a spring trip to Saudi Arabia in an effort to improve relations and **to propose a potential increase in oil exports.***

So the conditions are now set for Israel's modern-day descendants to be removed from nations around the world. These nations will be in varying degrees of turmoil and destruction; some of which is due to the foolish, selfish, and corrupt actions of Jacob's descendants.

*.....**Though I (God) make a full end of all nations** where I have scattered you, yet I will not make a complete end of you. But **I will correct you in justice, and I will not let you go unpunished** (Jer. 30:11b; Ed. note in parenthesis; emphasis added).*

After this period of correction and punishment, David will be resurrected from the dead, and begin the process of re-educating the descendants of Israel so they, in turn, can fulfill the job their forefathers failed to complete.

***But they shall serve the Lord their God, and David their king, whom I will raise up** (resurrect) **for them** (Jer. 30:9; Ed. note in parenthesis; emphasis added).*

The prophet Isaiah also described this last exodus of refugees, and it occurs at a time when the world's infrastructure has been thoroughly degraded, and various forms of transportation from earlier generations have to be used.

*Then they shall bring all your brethren for an offering to the Lord out of all nations, on horses and in chariots and in litters, on mules and on camels, to My holy mountain Jerusalem... (Isa. 66:20a).*

At this future time, the priesthood will be re-activated and it will serve all nations around the world.

*And I will also take some of them for priests and Levites, says the Lord (Isa. 66:21; cf. Eze. 44:15-16).*

*And it shall come to pass that from one New Moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, **all flesh shall come to worship before Me, says the Lord** (Isa. 66:23; cf. Isa. 2:2-4).*

And should any nation refuse to come to Jerusalem and listen to God's law being read during the Feast of Tabernacles, they will suffer the consequences (cf. Dt. 31:10-13).

*And it shall come to pass that **everyone who is left of all the nations** which came against Jerusalem **shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.** And it shall be that **whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem, on them there will be no rain.** <sup>18</sup>*If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they shall have no rain; they shall receive the plague with which the Lord strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles (Zech. 14:16-18; cf. Eze. 36:38).**

This is describing one of God's "appointed times" that the ancient family of Israel was supposed to teach other nations, but they failed (cf. Lev. 23:1-44). Nonetheless, the descendants of this ancient family will fulfill the task of re-educating and re-building this planet after Christ binds the Adversary of mankind, as described in Revelation 20:1-10. However, between now and the fulfillment of these prophecies, many of Jacob's descendants, who have contributed to refugee crises, will become refugees themselves as they are removed from the countries they currently live in and they will be transported back to the Middle East.

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
